WHEREAS, 2 million adults in the U.S. are estimated to meet the criteria for severe gambling problems in a given year, and another 4-6 million would be considered to have mild or moderate gambling problems;

WHEREAS, problem gambling is treatable, and treatment is effective in minimizing harm to both individuals and to society as a whole;

WHEREAS, numerous individuals, professionals, and organizations have dedicated their efforts to educating the public about problem gambling and the availability and effectiveness of treatment;

WHEREAS, the National Council on Problem Gambling, the Illinois Department of Human Services, the Association in Behavioral Health Care/About Behavioral Change (ABC), Ecker Center for Behavioral Health, and other organizations that treat those with gambling disorders invite all residents of Elgin Township to participate in Problem Gambling Awareness Month.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it hereby resolved by the Elgin Township Board of Trustees, Kane County, Illinois, that March 2022 is Problem Gambling Awareness Month in Elgin Township.
