

The Kane County Guide to Community Services (<a href="www.kanecountyguide.org">www.kanecountyguide.org</a>) is a comprehensive website listing of health and human services available throughout Kane County. In addition to allowing individual residents to search for the help they need, many schools, churches, synagogues and non-profit agencies find the online guide an easy-to-use resource to locate resources for their communities. The guide contains information for 1,167 organizations with 3,670 health & human services in our area as well as national resources. Agency profiles include contact information, websites, hours, disability access, fees, eligibility requirements, and service descriptions. Staff continuously review program information to ensure the information is accurate and current. In 2017, 34 new records were added and 1,121 records were revised.

The Kane County Guide utilizes the Alliance of Information and Referral Systems, (AIRS) Taxonomy. AIRS is a professional association of I&R providers that seeks to improve access to services for all people through information and referral. Use of the taxonomy also provides benefits to providers, in that it automatically sorts data according to need types. Available resources include:
