- * Township Community Rooms have been used by 3,702 citizens in 2017, representing 33 citizen groups.
- * The Elgin Township building has been designated a Westside Branch of Senior Service Associates since July 2003 and has contracted with Elgin Township to perform 3 days a week programming for Seniors on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays.
- * In 2017, 11,804 phone calls were received and 1,763 persons were assisted in the office, averaging 1,131 persons assisted each month.

 Expenditures for General Assistance in 2017 were \$119,626.00 averaging 33 clients per month.

 Expenditures for Emergency Assistance in 2017 were \$46,958.69 averaging 10 families assisted each month.
- * Annually, Elgin Township files claims for reimbursements from the Illinois Department of Human Services for services provided while citizens' applications are pending review with Social Security Disability Program. In 2017, \$17,706.00 was collected from the State, which totaled \$287,646.63 since the recovery program started in 1996.
