Economic Crisis Program: The EC Financial and Case Managers provided the following to Elgin Township residents:

- **1,414** Elgin Township residents received **18,307** hours of service
- **31** Elgin Township households received **\$35,490.70** in financial assistance for rent or utility
- **649** households received **12,163** meals from our Emergency Food Pantry
- **283** households received a November Holiday Food Box
- **289** households received **13,685** diapers/wipes; **596** households received **22,409** toiletries; **243** households received **788** rolls of toilet paper
- **94** clients received **311** one-ride bus tickets; **131** households received **263** all-day bus tickets
- **606** households received food pantry referrals; **178** households received clothing referrals; **49** households received **70** pairs of shoes or boots; and **56** clients received **130** blankets
- **10** households received eyeglass referrals to the Elgin Lion's Club
- **104** households received **373** pairs of socks; **26** households received **114** underwear garments
- **217** households received **691** coats, **229** households received **691** hats, **254** households received **843** pairs of gloves, and **165** households received **373** scarves

EC Shelter: A total of **59** women were sheltered for **872** nights and **43** children for **703** nights; **80%** (**26** women and **21** children) listed an Elgin Township address. An additional **29** women and **22** children from Elgin Township were sheltered due to domestic violence.

Financial Report: **58%** of the total grant has been spent through 3/31/18 (\$35,000). This includes **74.5%** of the cost of Personnel, **68.5%** for EC Shelter, and **12.5%** for nonperishable food for the Emergency Food Pantry.

EC Shelter: \$5,477.91
Emergency Food Pantry: \$626.47
