ELGN TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE ON SENIORS FUNDING SENIOR CITIZEN PROGRAMS IN ELGIN TOWNSHIP, IL REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS .

Elgin Township, IL — Elgin Township's Committee on Seniors announces Request For Proposals (RFP) to fund programs for Seniors residing in Elgin Township.

The request for funding is restricted to supporting the following services within the five (5) broad categories: (1) Transportation; (2) Wellness; (3) Age in Place; (4) Legal and Financial Management; and (5) Socialization. A Nonprofit 501(c)3 Agency can apply for more than one category but must submit a separate proposal for each category. Proposals are due no later than close of business on May 14, 2021.

"I am proud of the due diligence and hard work the members of the Committee on Seniors provided when deciding how to best utilize tax dollars secured through the 2017 Elgin Township Senior Referendum," said Franklin Ramirez, "On behalf of the Elgin Township, we look forward to their recommendations for funding Senior Citizen programs in Elgin Township." It is estimated that \$437,000 in yearly tax dollars will be secured from the Senior Referendum for 2021. To date, the Committee on Seniors has disbursed over one million dollars to fund senior programs in Elgin Township.

The Committee on Seniors are appointed volunteers from Elgin Township who began meeting in September 2018. The Committee meets monthly on the fourth Thursday of each month at 6pm either in person at the Elgin Township Offices or, due to COVID-19, via Zoom video conference.

Proposal Format and Requirements:

The request for funding is restricted to supporting Senior US Citizens and Senior Legal US Residents in Elgin Township remaining independent and to age in place and outlines one of the following services within the five (5) broad categories:

- Transportation
- Wellness
- Age in Place
- Legal and Financial Management
- Socialization

A Nonprofit 501(c)3 Agency can apply for more than one category but must submit a separate proposal for each category.

Please provide a proposal of seven pages or less and include:

- Brief background of the Nonprofit -- 501(c)(3) Agency.
- Explanation of the program and, if applicable, if it is currently offered by Nonprofit agency and explanation of how it is currently being funded.
- Specific program budget with no more than 10% of monies requested be used for general administrative costs.
- Goals and objectives of program and how success is determined.
- Marketing and outreach plan for program.
- How Elgin Township will be recognized by Nonprofit agency.

Proposals are due no later than close of business on May 14, 2021.

- May 14, 2021: Proposals due by end of business day.
- May 17, 2021: Proposals distributed to Committee on Seniors Members for review.
- May 26, 2021: Discussion of proposals and approve recommendations for awarding.
- June 14, 2021: Presentation to Elgin Township Supervisor and Trustees at their monthly meeting.
- June 14, 2021: Approval of Committee on Seniors recommendation on funding at Trustees monthly meeting.
- June 15-30th, 2021: RFP Applicants notified by e-mail on decision to award funding.
- July 1 2021: 2nd Year (2020-2021) approved Grant Recipients must electronically send their Final Report to Elgin Township Supervisor.
- December 2021: 3rd Year (2021-2022) approved Grant Recipients must electronically send their Mid-year Report due to Elgin Township Supervisor.
