Supervisor's Report

- * Elgin Township TRIAD is made up of citizens and local agency and service providers as a formal association. Its members vote officers in annually and community events are planned, promoted and carried out by its members and committees, since July 1998.
- * Township Community Rooms have been used by 4,000 citizens in 2018, representing 31 citizen groups.
- * The Elgin Township building has been designated a Westside Branch of Senior Service Associates since July 2003 and has contracted with Elgin Township to perform 3 days a week programming for Seniors on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays.
- * In 2018, 8,975 phone calls were received and 1,860 persons were assisted in the office, averaging 903 persons assisted each month.
Expenditures for General Assistance in 2018 were \$131,352 averaging 30 clients per month.
Expenditures for Emergency Assistance in 2018 were \$71,201 averaging 14 families assisted each month.
- * Annually, Elgin Township files claims for reimbursements from the Illinois Department of Human Services for services provided while citizens' applications are pending review with Social Security Disability Program. In 2018, \$30,551.28 was collected from the State, which totaled \$318,197.91 since the recovery program started in 1996.
