- * Elgin Township TRIAD is made up of citizens and local agency and service providers as a formal association. Its members vote officers in annually and community events are planned, promoted and carried out by its members and committees, since July 1998.
- * Township Community Rooms have been used by 4,431 citizens in 2019, representing 35 citizen groups.
- * The Elgin Township building has been designated a Westside Branch of Senior Service Associates since July 2003 and has contracted with Elgin Township to perform 3 days a week programming for Seniors on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays.
- * In 2019, 8,555 phone calls were received and 1781 persons were assisted in the office, averaging 148 persons assisted each month.
Expenditures for General Assistance in 2019 were \$131,314.10 averaging 30 clients per month.
Expenditures for Emergency Assistance in 2019 were \$103,008.80 averaging 21 families assisted each month.
- * Annually, Elgin Township files claims for reimbursements from the Illinois Department of Human Services for services provided while citizens' applications are pending review with Social Security Disability Program. In 2019, \$29,485.00 was collected from the State, which totaled \$347,682.91 since the recovery program started in 1996.
