Based on the rapidly evolving situation with COVID-19 and recommendations from public health officials to practice "social distancing", the **Elgin Township Assessor's office** has decided that while our office will be fully staffed, we will be closing **our doors to the general public until further notice**. This decision did not come lightly but was made in the best interest of our residents and our staff.

At this time, assistance from our office with completing exemptions has been suspended until further notice.

- Out of concern for "social distancing" in response to COVID-19, you do not need to submit exemption forms in person, but can submit them by mail or fax to the Kane County Supervisor of Assessments.
- The July 1 deadline for the Senior Freeze exemption has been extended to October 1.

Effective immediately, **the Kane County Assessment Office will be closed to visitors (except by appointment only) until further notice**. The office will remain staffed and open for telephone calls and on-line business.
