YOUTH MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION

The Elgin Township Committee on Youth is a volunteer committee which serves in an advisory capacity to the Elgin Township Board of Trustees. 2. Completion of a short questionnaire describing why the applicant is interested in joining the Committee on Youth and what the applicant would hope to contribute. Include a listing of any relevant volunteer or work experiences.
3. Two letters of recommendation; one must be from a History or Civics class teacher.
