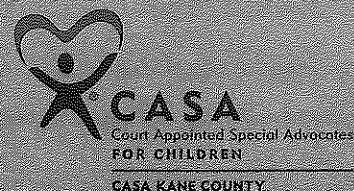


Dear Mr. Ramirez:
