This program will provide the eligible recipients with assistance toward utility bills (gas, water, electric).

Elgin Township will award a limited number of applicants age 65 and older with \$500 toward the utility bill/bills of your choosing. The utility bill/bills must be in the applicants name and for the current address. One application per household.

Requirements:

Who may apply?

1. Applicants' must be current U.S. Citizens
2. Medicare recipient
3. Age 65 or older as of Jan. 1 of 2021
and
4. A resident of Elgin Township, Kane County

What must my income be in order to qualify?

Total yearly income:

Single person: Not more than \$29,000 annual gross income

Married persons: Not more than \$35,000 annual gross income (combined)

When can I apply?

Application period begins July 1, 2021 and ends August 31, 2021

To whom do I apply?

When delivering your completed application you must also bring your:

Current Medicare Card

Drivers License or State Issued Photo ID

Copy of your Federal Income Tax Return filed the previous year or the current
Social Security Award letter if taxes are not filed

Current utility bill/bills for which you want to apply the funding toward

(must be in applicants name for current address)

HOW WILL I KNOW IF I'M APPROVED FOR THE PROGRAM?

Elgin Township Office will notify you by letter of approval. Elgin Township will also
notify all other applicants if not approved.

All qualifying persons may reapply each year.

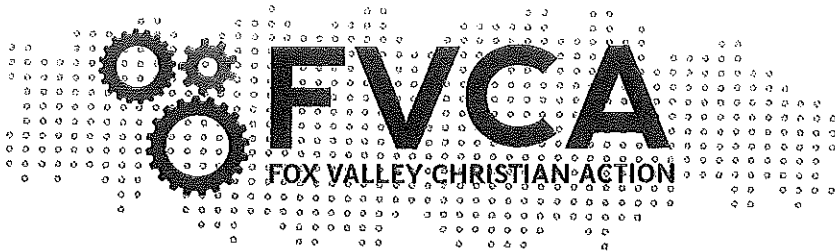
