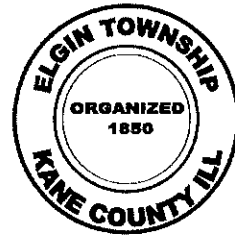
1. Name, address, phone number, name of high school, year in high school and age.
